

North American Enduro Cup Covid19 Policy and Procedures

The NAEC and Kellogg, ID are hosting racers from across the United States. It is important for us to put on a safe event for racers, staff, volunteers and the host community. Everyone has a critical role and a shared responsibility for creating and maintaining a healthy environment and a safe event.

Any violation of this NAEC Covid19 policy and procedure may result in disqualification.

Mask Policy

The Silver Mountain Resort Outdoor Movie Venue (in front of the water park) is your NAEC Base of Operations (N-BO) for race weekend. Racer check-in, packet pickup, timing, neutral support and podiums will all be at the N-BO. Saturday Call Ups will be across the street from the gondola in the Call Up Arena, on the Trail of the Coeur d'Alene. **Masks must be worn at all times in the Call Up Arena and N-BO.**

We strongly encourage you to wear a mask in other places like the gondola, lift and stage start lines where racers are stacking up.

If you're riding a lift or the gondola with someone you don't know, please be safe and respectful of the other person.

If you want to ride the gondola solo, you can. Let the operator know and they can send you up in a cabin with your bike. You do not need to load your bike into a cabin with the truck tailgate style pad if you are loading solo.

When in doubt, wear a mask.

Packet Pick Up Procedures

- **Waivers will be sent to each racer electronically.**
- Registration hours will be extended to allow for distancing. **Racers must make an appointment to pick up racer packets.** Go to www.naenduro.com to schedule.
- Only racers and if needed, guardians (for waivers) should attend packet pick up.

Course and Race Protocols

- Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the event and race area.
- There will be no in person rider briefing. The rider briefing information will be posted on NAEC social media channels, website and emailed to racers.
- All timing chips will be disinfected before packet pick up.
- Post-race chip readout will be self-service by the rider in the N-BO.
- There will be an aid station with water and Clif products. All food and water products will be individually wrapped. All waste must be disposed of in the trash or packed out.

Awards Ceremony Protocol

- Racers must wear mask in N-BO and while on podium.
- Medals will be placed on a table and riders must collect their own medals during the award ceremony.
- Each category will have an award time and will be posted TBA.
- Only family and friends of podiums may attend awards during designated award time.
- All attendees attending awards must be masked and maintain 6 feet distancing.
